2. In the **Science Group, Shubham Agrawal** topped the school with 95% marks and also achieved 0.1% CBSE Merit Certificate for a score of 100% in **IP**.
3. In the **Commerce Stream, Sejal Kukreja** scored 92.8% and topped the school.
4. **Harsh Garhwal** was awarded with 0.1% CBSE Merit Certificate for a score of 100% in **IP**.
5. The subject toppers in **AISSCE Class XII** were 32 students.
