	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>Teams will be provided accommodation in the school campus separately for Boy &amp; Girls.</li><li>Teams will be completely responsible for safety of expensive items and all their belongings.</li><li>Accommodation request will only be entertained after receiving complete Travel Plan, Assurance Letter/ Consent of Participation, and Team photograph till 12<sup>th</sup> Sep. 2024. Accommodation request after 5<sup>th</sup> Aug. would only be of rooms considered subject to availability of rooms.</li><li>Accommodation on campus will be provided on first come first serve basis and maybe considered confirmed only after Receiving our Confirmation at the time of reporting as limited rooms are available at campus. Therefore, please call us and confirm telephonically in advance.</li></ol>

17	Essential	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>A lady teacher MUST ACCOMPANY the girls' team.</li><li>Parents will not be entertained with the team.</li><li>All teams are requested to bring School uniform, School flag, lock &amp; key, torch, mosquito repellents, First Aid etc.</li></ol>
18	Travel Plan	Please mail your travel plan latest by 12th Sep. 2024, by 1:00pm positively.

- ❖ All the teams shall be accompanied by a Teacher/Coach/Manager designated by the participating school Principal.
- ❖ No team will be permitted to participate without accompanying official.
- ❖ No team shall be accompanied by any parent. However, if a parent is accompanying the team, such information may be provided by the school on the school letterhead.
- ❖ Note am shall be accompanied by more than two officials.
- ❖ In case of Girl participants, one of the accompanying officials must be a female.
- ❖ The officials accompanying the team shall have a valid Identity Card issued by their school Principal.
- ❖ No extra person shall be permitted to stay inside the school premises and on the play field along with the teams.

## **GENERAL/MANDATORY INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Taking part in Opening ceremony, march past & closing ceremony is mandatory for all schools and players.
2. Escort Coach/Manager shall be held responsible for their students' behavior manners and language; any default shall be reported to their school Principal/Management.
3. At time of event in progress only participating or qualified students/athletes shall be entitled to enter table tennis arena, other players shall be expected to stay out of play arena.
4. Players must give their attendance to official 45min prior to scheduled time of event.
5. It is mandatory for all coaches/managers/players to wear school identity card during days of meet irrespective of whether they are in or out of school campus.
6. It is mandatory for all the schools to deposit total amount for all the days of tournament as per CBSE norms at the time of reporting.
7. Student's movement after 8:00 pm outside their accommodation room shall not be permitted.
8. It is mandatory for all Coaches & Managers to stay with students in allotted accommodation/room.
9. Bringing or use of tobacco sachets, cigarettes, and liquor is strictly prohibited in school campus. If any coach/manager/student is found drunk or smoking on campus, his/her team shall be disqualified with immediate effect and same will be informed to their principal.
10. Only Vegetarian meals will be served in school campus.
11. The host school shall not be responsible for any incident which happens out of school campus during outing of any coach/manager/team or players.

## **IMPORTANT: IT SHALL BE MANDATORY**

### **Age:**

The athlete/player should be within the particular age group on 31st December of the year of tournament.

- a) Only bonafide students (with CBSE Reg. No. shall be eligible to participate in the Inter-School tournaments/meets. Filling names of any non bonafide student shall lead to disqualification of the team.
- b) A student, who has failed twice in a particular class, shall no more be eligible to participate.
- c) In complete information in any respect is liable for disqualification of team.
- d) Any violation in eligibility (over age or Impersonation) shall be deal according to rules.

- e) The original eligibility Performa of the Athletes/Players/Teams qualifying to participate from Cluster/Zone level to National level will have to be certified by the Organizing school at the Cluster/Zone level as the case may be and forwarded to the National Organizing School, immediately after their Cluster/Zone level tournament is over.
- f) Medical checkup may also be applied by the Jury of Appeal appointed by the Organizing school in the case of overage objection.
- g) A player shall be under 14; 17; &19 years of age on 31ST Dec 2024.
- Under 14 years: Born on or after 01.01.2011
  - Under 17 years: Born on or after 01.01.2008
  - Under 19 years: Born on or after 01.01.2006
- h) All the supporting papers verifying the age of the player, etc. in original, as per the CBSE Guidelines & Rules shall be carried personally by the Team Manager/Coach while reporting for participation.
- i) The player's right to participate forfeits on failing to produce the papers supporting the eligibility in original on demand.

Any team/athlete not fulfilling the eligibility criteria before the commencement of the tournament/meet shall not be permitted to participate.

**IMPORTANT: IT SHALL BE MANDATORY FOR ALL THE PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS TO PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING ON ARRIVAL AT VENUE-**

- 1) The documents for verification in original when asked for.
- 2) The team photo with school Principal along with the entry Performa, countersigned by the Concerned Principal.
- 3) To supply the eligibility Performa filled-in online, countersigned by the concerned Principal.
